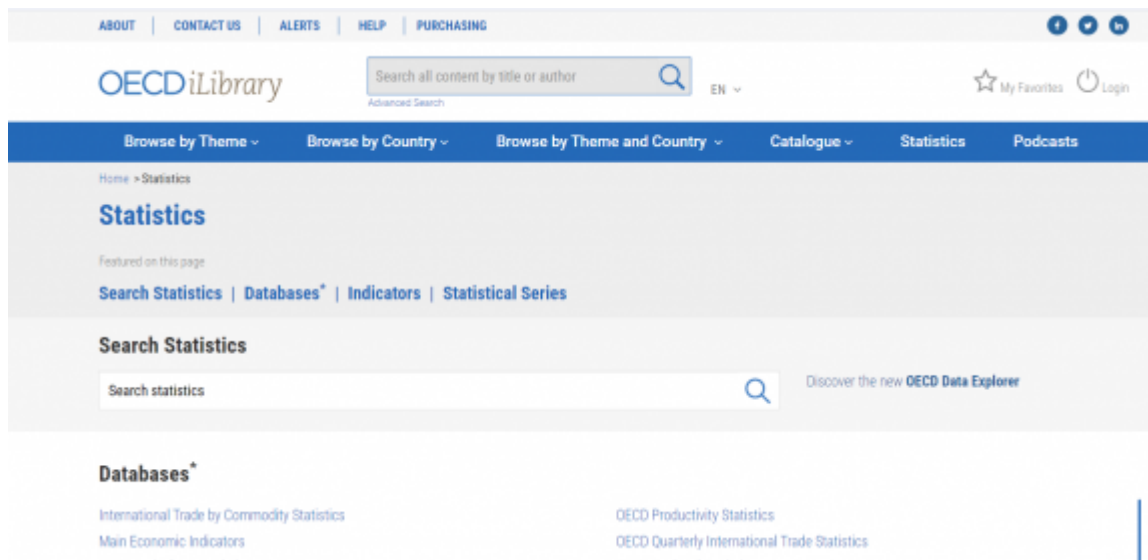

This database included data from more than 40 databases collecting demographic, social, economic and environmental developments for its member countries and major additional countries. OECD countries covered include Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Korea, Luxembourg, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Poland, Portugal, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, the United Kingdom, and the United States. Non-OECD countries covered include Brazil, China, India, Indonesia, Russia, and South Africa. 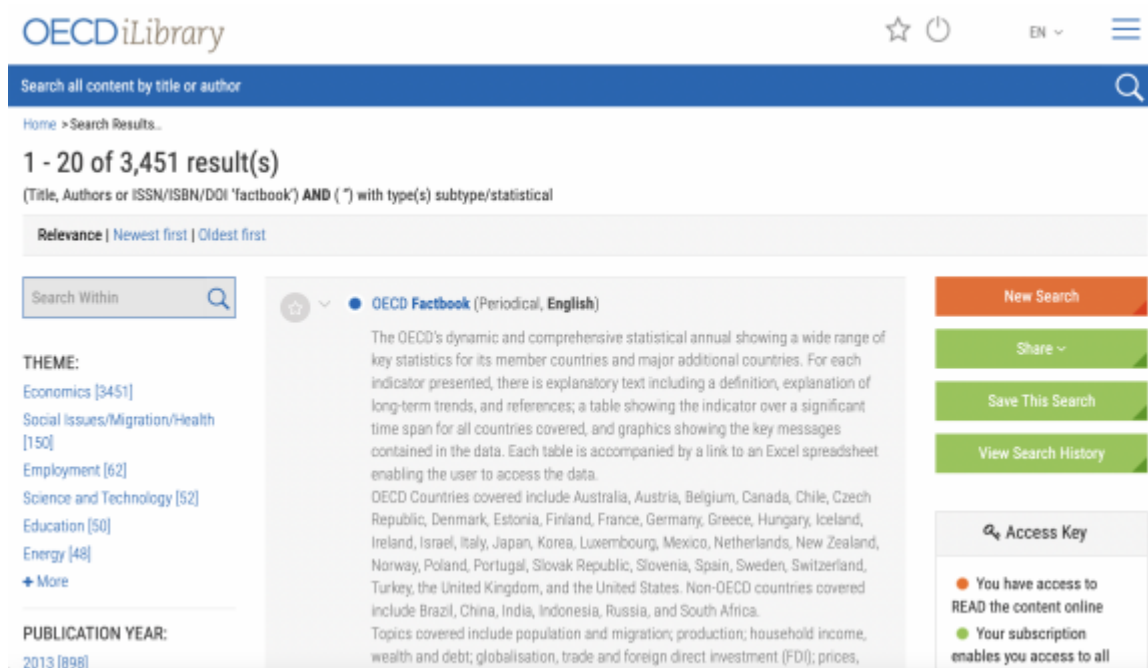

Step 1.) Navigate to the home page of OECD iLibrary

Step 2.) Type “Factbook” in the Search bar by either the upper right-hand corner near the microscope or in the “Search statistics” bar and enter to search



Step 3.) Scroll down to select “OECD Factbook Statistics (Database, English)”
