
Primarily, the data team uses this dataset for a couple indicators:

For example, SeriesEdYearsAge25UNHDRO and SeriesEnvPaperRec%.


STEPS TO PULL DATA FROM UNDP

1. To pull from UNDP United Nations Development Programme, first navigate to https://hdr.undp.org/data-center




UNDP Pull Step 1

2. Scroll down. Under the header "What's inside" click the box "Human Development Index (HDI) ."




3. On the "Human Development Index (HDI)" page, scroll down and click "Downloads and Documentation"
